

# elecworks™ Tips & Tricks

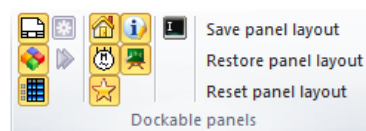
## View / Display Options

You may inadvertently turn off the *Documents browser* that's normally displayed down the left hand side of the elecworks screen or you may wish the Macro's browser to be turned off because your designs are one-offs and you don't need the Macros (circuit) option.

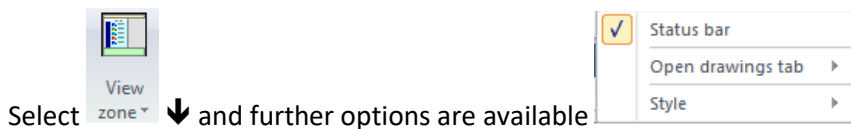
How do you do this?

Select the *View* ribbon tab

On the *View* panel > *Dockable panels* >, you can select the options that are available:



The options that are available are **context sensitive** to the type of drawing that you are in. The *Cabinet layout browser* as an example will only become available when you go into a panel layout drawing.



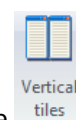
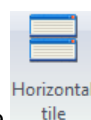
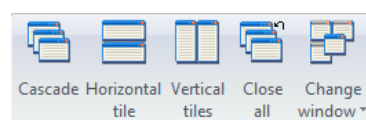
Select **View zone** ↓ and further options are available

The *Open drawings tab* allows you to define where the tabs for the open drawings are located (top, bottom, left, right)

The *Style* allows you to personalise the appearance of elecworks™

Select the *Window* ribbon tab

From the *Window* panel, further options for display are available:



If you wish to have multiple drawings tiled, then the **Horizontal tile** and the **Vertical tiles** are worth selecting
