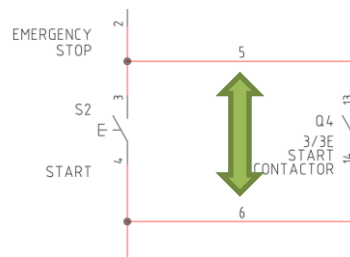


Swap Wire Numbers

AutoCAD Electrical 2019

When you have created several schematics and then modifications are made, the wire numbering order can be out of sequence in accordance with the project or drawing properties.

If the project hasn't reached production, the easiest method of renumbering is to perform a *Tag/Retag All*. However, if you are just wanting to swap a single pair of wire numbers around, the easiest method is to use *Swap Wire Numbers*. The command simply swaps around the wire numbers of the two wires selected.



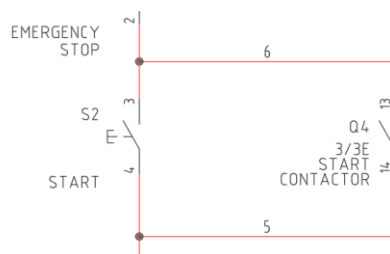
In the above example we would like to swap wire number 5 and replace with wire number 6 (and vice-versa)


Select *Schematic* ribbon tab > *Edit Wires/Wire Numbers* panel >  dropdown  >  Swap

Left click on the 1st wire or wire number

Left click on the 2nd wire or wire number

The wire numbers are then swapped



The command allows you to continue with your selections. *Right click* or  to accept the changes
