

Changing the Project Directory's Path

All Electrical Designer Users

When you install or configure Electrical Designer you can specify the directory paths for projects (PR), libraries (LI), catalogues (CA), templates (M) and reports (F).

As an example all projects will have their own unique sub-directory within the PR directory.

However you are able to have your own unique directory location for each project and furthermore a unique structure on a per customer basis or on a machine type basis.

An example of this is that you may have a directory tree of:

<i>Projects</i>	<i>Customer Name</i>	<i>Project Name</i>
\PR\ 	ABC\ 	ABC123
	XYZ\ 	XYZ987

This enables you to have all of a particular customer's projects located in their own directory tree structure and therefore easily identifiable from Windows Explorer.

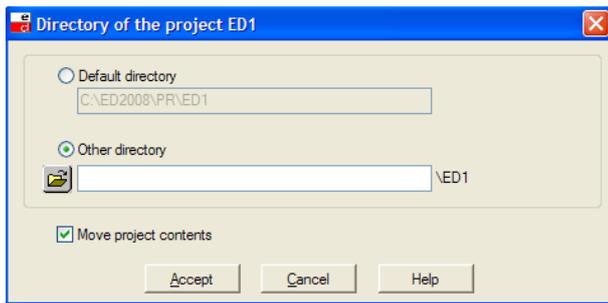
Modifying the path of an existing project:

A path of a project can be easily changed.

Simply select the command  *Edit Project*

Select *Directory*

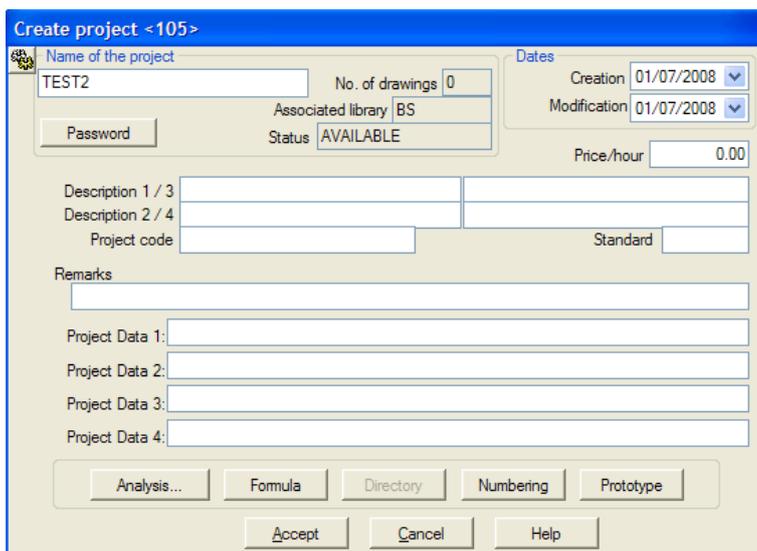
Select *Other Directory*



Ensure that *Move Project Contents* is ticked
 Select  to browse to the new location
 Select *Accept* after the new location is selected
 Select *Accept* to close the Edit Project dialogue

Specifying the path of a new project:

The *Directory* option in the *Create Project* dialogue does not become available until the project has been created.



Therefore you have to create the project in the default Electrical Designer directory location. Once done, you can follow the steps defined in “*Modifying the path of an existing project*”.
