Quick Display Tip 6 – Adding the “Old Style” Tool Bars

Although the Ribbon gives access the majority of AutoCAD tools used on a day to day basis, switching from Tab to Tab to find the required tool can sometimes be time consuming. An alternative option to this may be to bring on the “Old Style” tool bars, working with both the tool bars and the Ribbon may also be good transitional stage, prior to moving across to the Ribbon only.

The individual tool bars may be added by selecting the View tab and selecting the Toolbar Icon at the right of the tab.

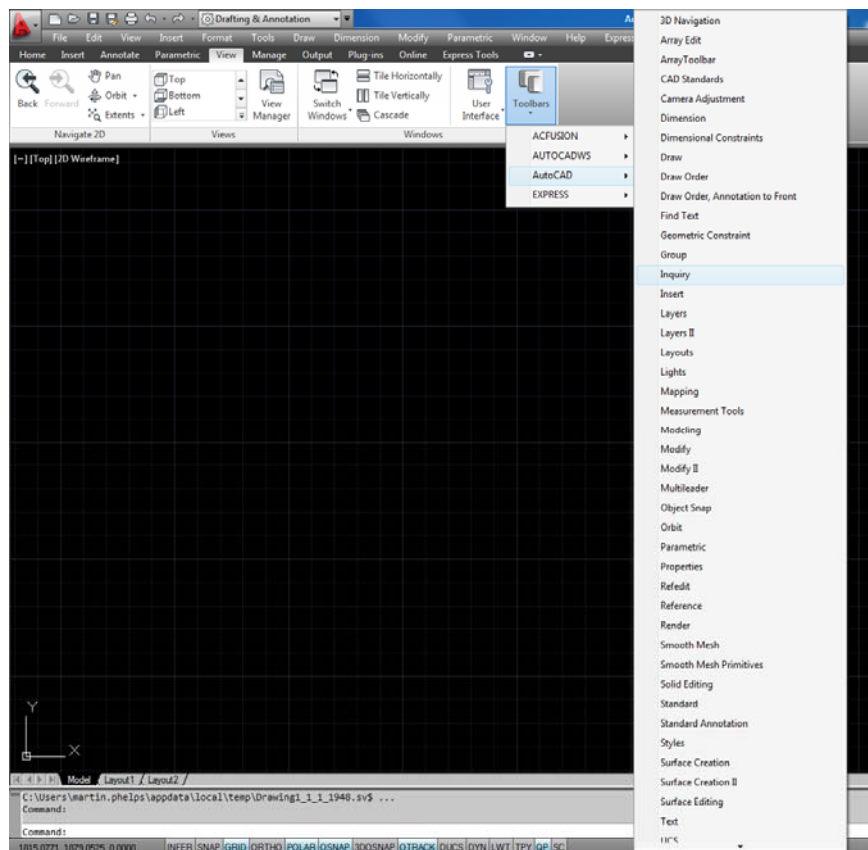

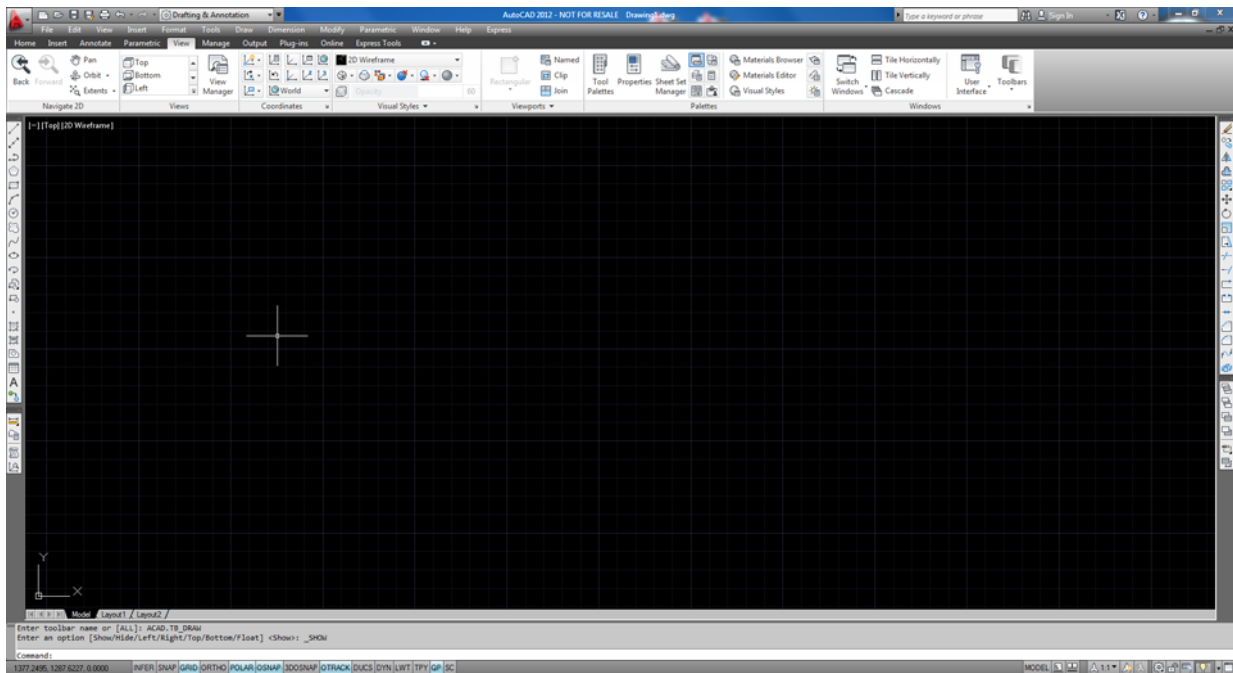

Once selected a menu will be displayed, from this the option AutoCAD can be selected, a menu list of all the available AutoCAD tool bars is displayed, the required toolbar can now be picked from the list. Any toolbar with a tick is currently displayed in the work area.

Instead of repeating this process to add another toolbar, simply right click on any icon within the tool bar and the tool bar list will be displayed.

The following image shows the Draw, Inquiry, Modify and Draw Order tool bars added to the standard Ribbon menu set up.
