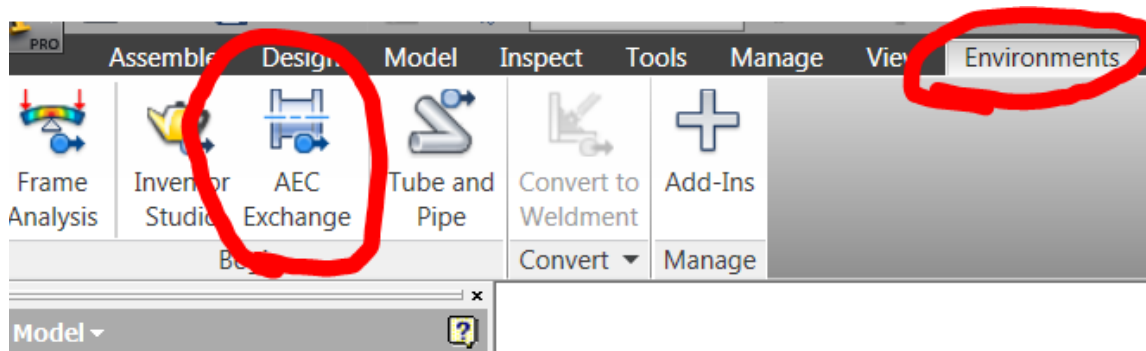


# ADSK file export – Creating an ADSK file from Autodesk Inventor 2010/2011

This White Paper will guide you through the steps necessary create an ADSK file in Autodesk Inventor 2010/2011.

Intermediate Inventor Users

With the Inventor Model open, click on the **Environments** Tab, then choose **AEC Exchange**

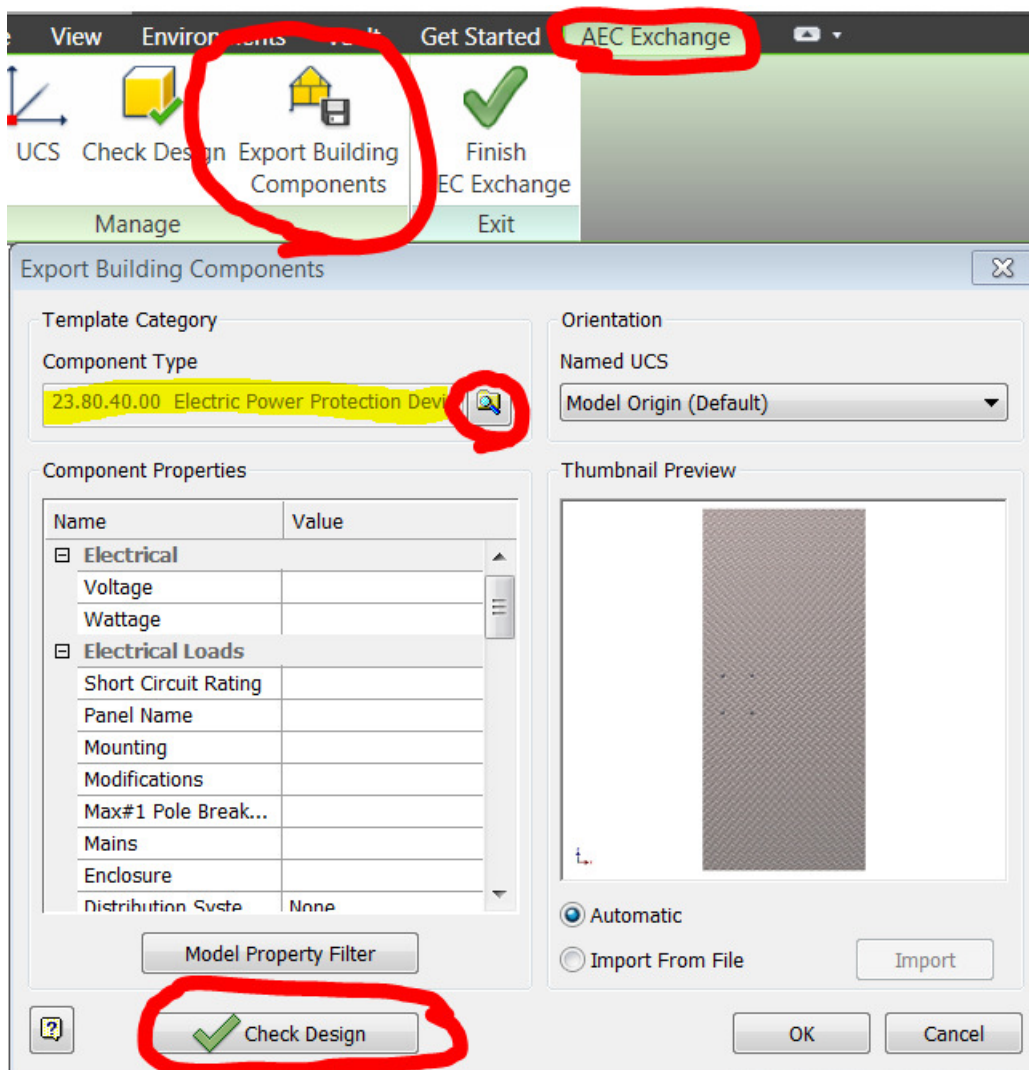


This will launch the AEC exchange Tab, Click on **Export Building Components**

The Export Building Components dialogue box will pop up. Click on the **Browse Button**

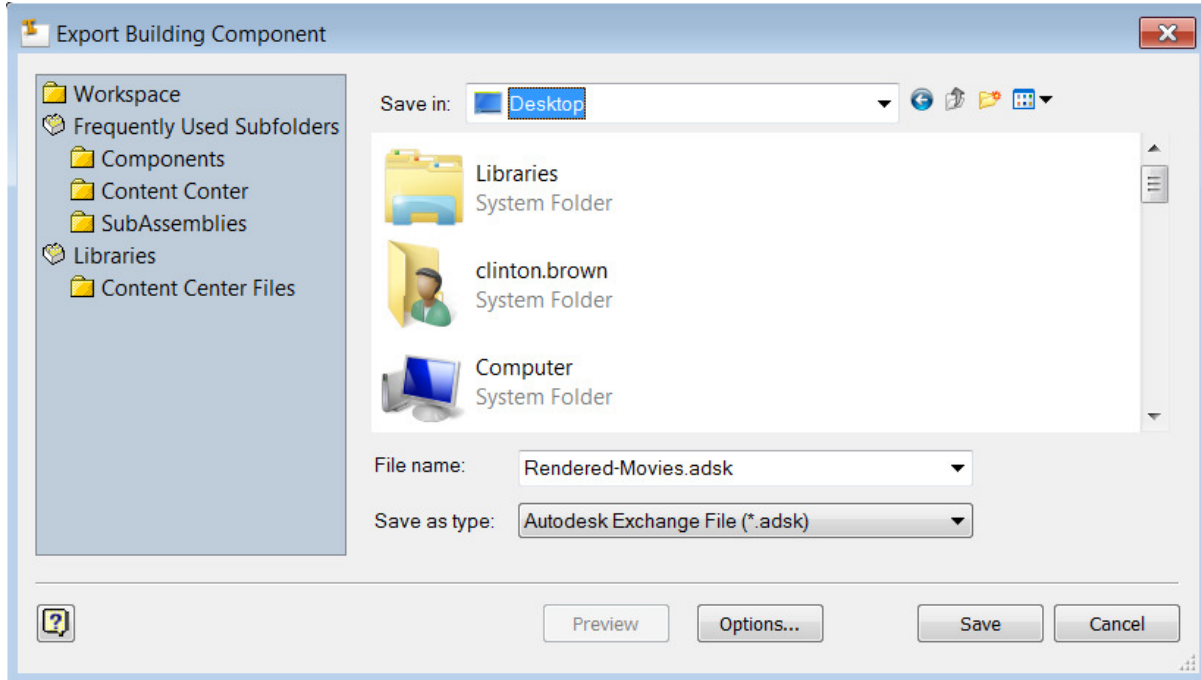


You now need to select the component type that you are going to be exporting from a list. In this example, I have chosen Electric Power Protection Devices.

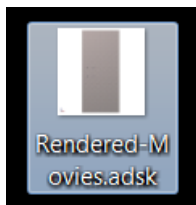
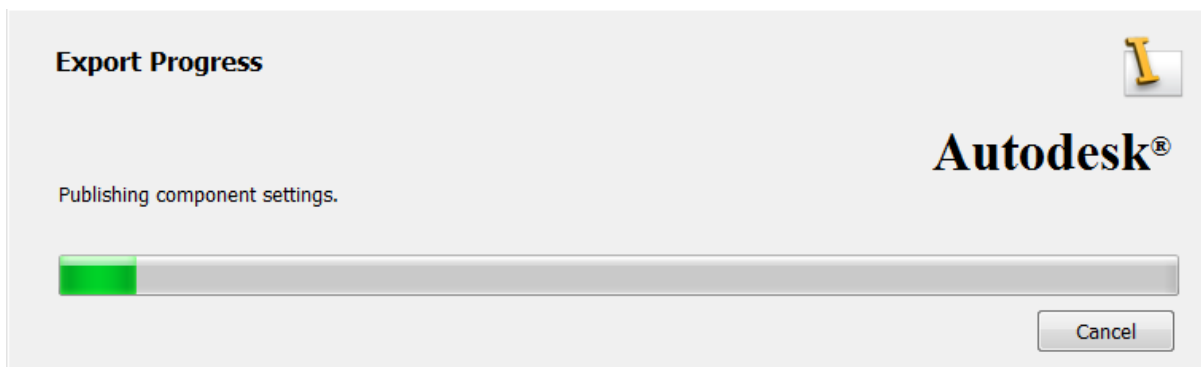


Once you have chosen your Component Type, click on **Check Design**, then click on **OK**

Select a location to save the file to (if this is different to the Inventor file, you will get a message about the project file, you can ignore this and continue)



The system will now export your file.
