

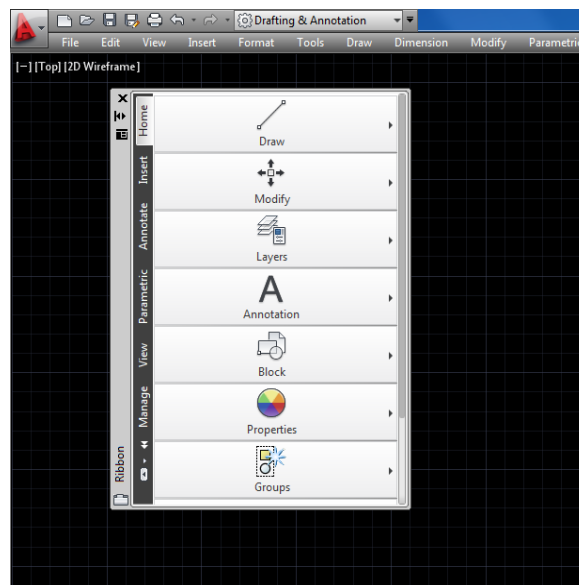
# Positioning the Ribbon

AutoCAD Users

## Changing the user interface

### Quick Display Tip 5 – Positioning the Ribbon.

The default position for the ribbon is at the top of the screen, but the ribbon can be positioned to suit the user, right click on any tab and select undock from the menu, this will allow the ribbon to float, and therefore be positioned anywhere on the screen.



The ribbon now behaves like any of the Pallets that may be displayed with in AutoCAD, including the options to change the size of the Pallet, and also use auto hide tools from different Tabs and Panels can be accessed in the normal way.

By selecting the Pallet header bar the Ribbon now Pallet may be dragged to any location within the drawing area, or docked to the left and right hand sides, or returned back to its original position at the top of the screen.

## NOTE

If the Ribbon is being used as a Pallet, it can be accidently closed to reinstate the Ribbon simply type the word Ribbon at the command line.
