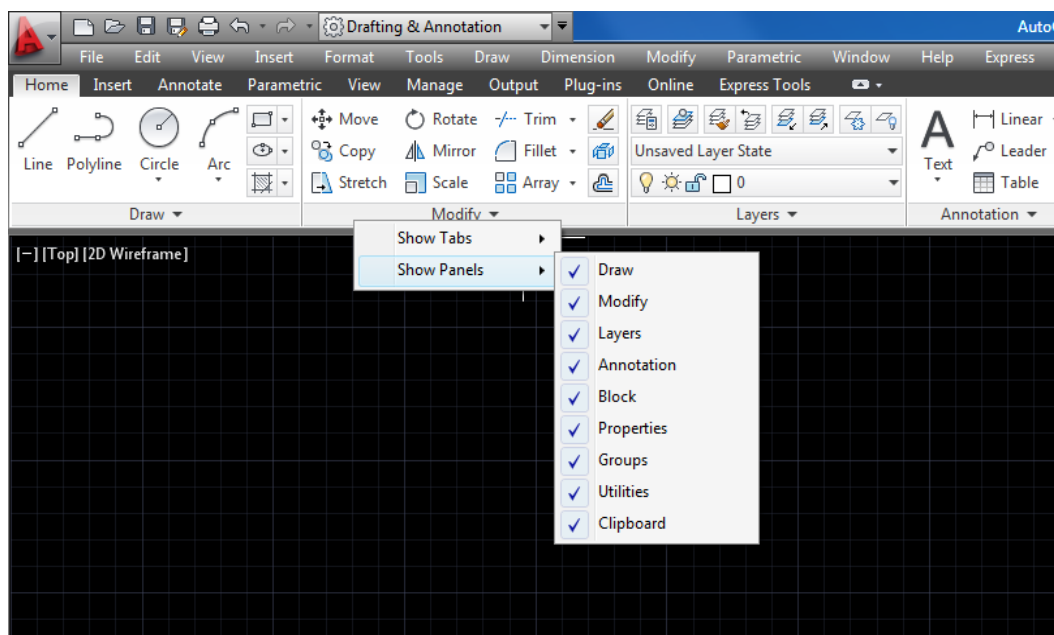
Changing the user interface

Quick Display Tip 4 – Controlling the Tab and Panel Display in the Ribbon.

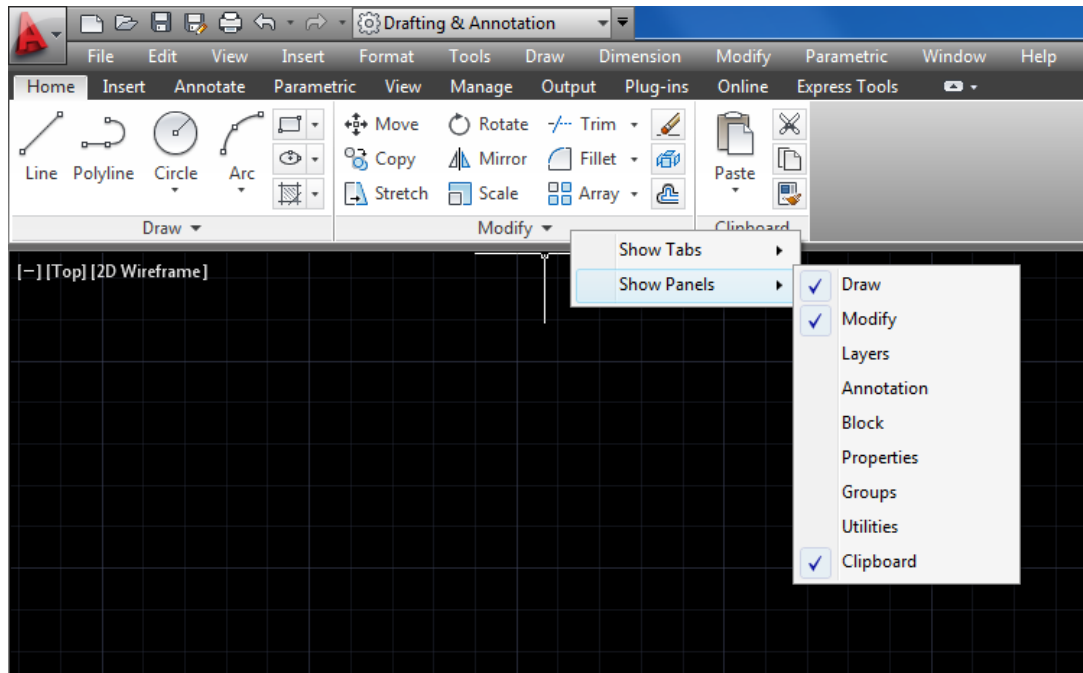
Since the ribbon is comprised of a number of tabs, and the tabs are comprised of a number of panels, both the display of the tabs and the panels may be controlled. For example if certain tabs or panels are not required they may be temporary removed and reinstated later if that set of tools are required.

This can be achieved in two ways, either;

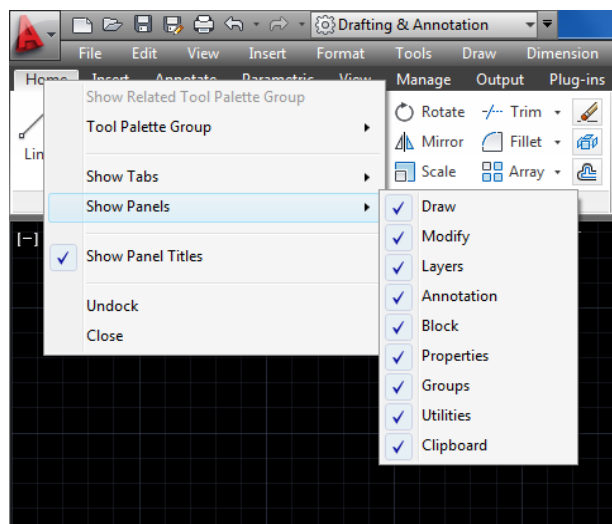
1. Right click on the panel heading, from the menu displayed select either Show Tabs or Show Panels, a list of Tabs or Panels will be displayed, from this list the user can decide which Tabs and Panels to display.



The example below shows the home Tab with only the Draw, Modify, and Clipboard Panels shown, all other Panels have been removed.



2. Right click on one of the Tabs, again this will show a menu from which Show Tabs or Show Panels can be selected.



Another option in this menu gives the user the option to show or not to show the Panel Titles, this will also slightly increase the drawing area, but keep the Ribbon in its original format, as below.
