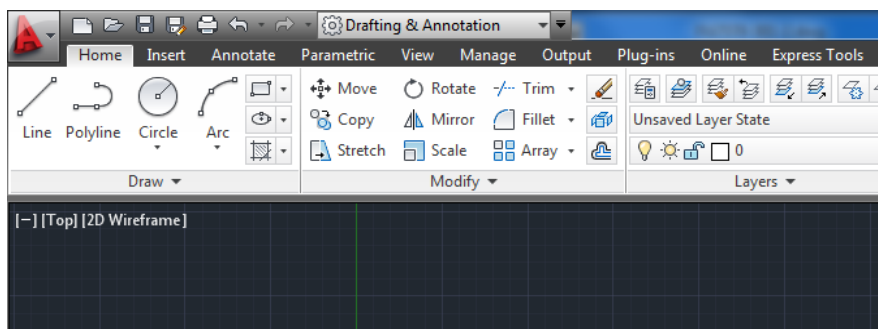

Changing the user interface

Quick Display Tip 1 – Changing AutoCAD back to the Classic User Interface.

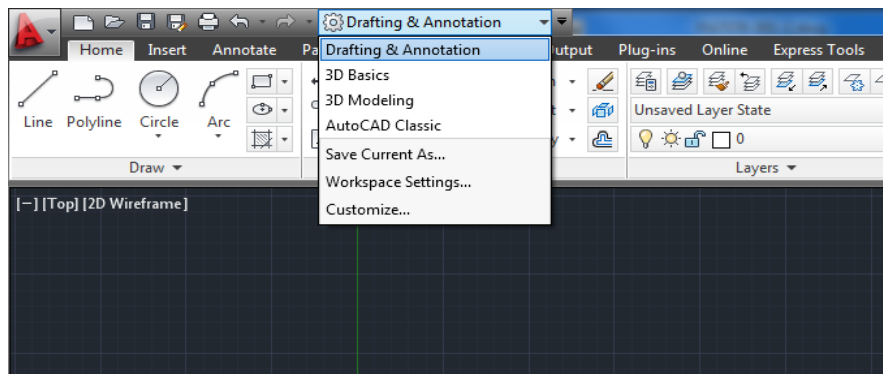
Most AutoCAD users have now come to expect the change of tradition and moved away from the old toolbars to ribbon menu, however a number of users still prefer the old toolbar setup.

To revert back to the old or “Classic” set up is very easily accomplished; this may be done by changing the work space as shown below.

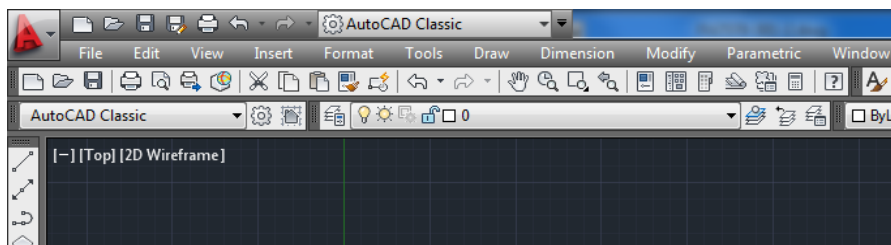


By default AutoCAD 2012 has the Ribbon Menus displayed.

But by using the drop down list from the “Quick Access Toolbar” the work space may be changed to the “Classic” set up.



The AutoCAD “Classic” view shown below, back to the pull down menus and toolbars.



Personally I would try and get to know the Ribbon menu, since it can be a quicker way to access standard tools. This method of changing the user interface works with all versions of “Vanilla” AutoCAD, since the introduction of the Ribbon back in Release 2009, and was a common technical support query.
