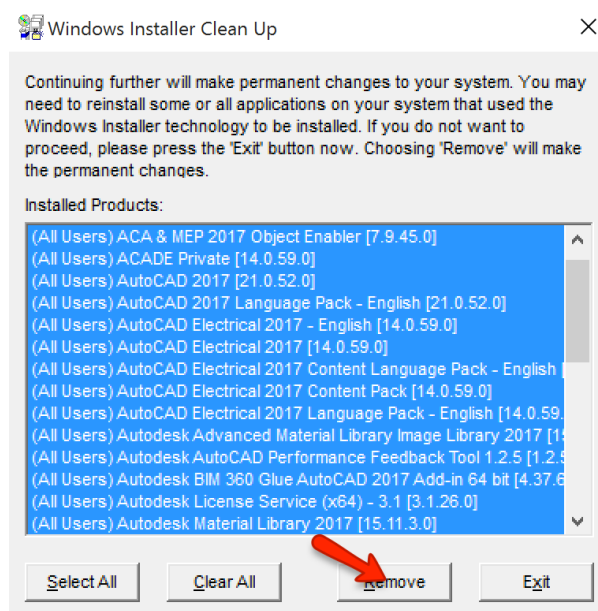


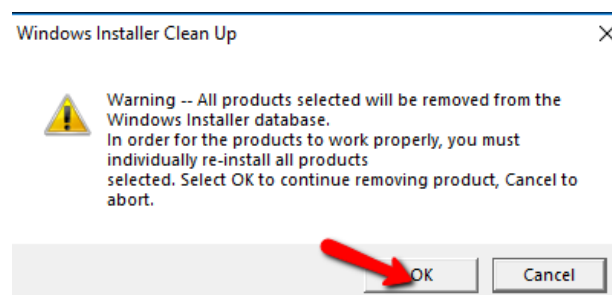
How to manually un-install AutoCAD Electrical

If you are having issues un-installing AutoCAD Electrical through the standard Programs and Features applet due to Windows errors then you can follow the below procedure:

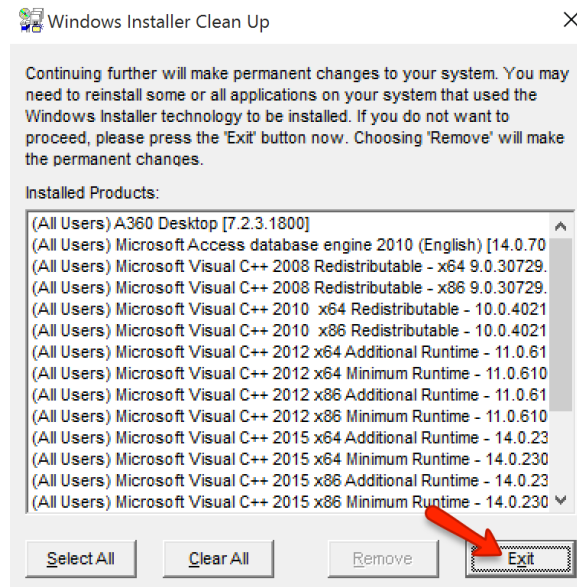
- Install the Windows Clean-Up Utility from the below link:
 - o <http://autode.sk/2xvVyhE>
- Run the utility and select all Electrical components and remove



- OK the Windows Installer Clean up warning message

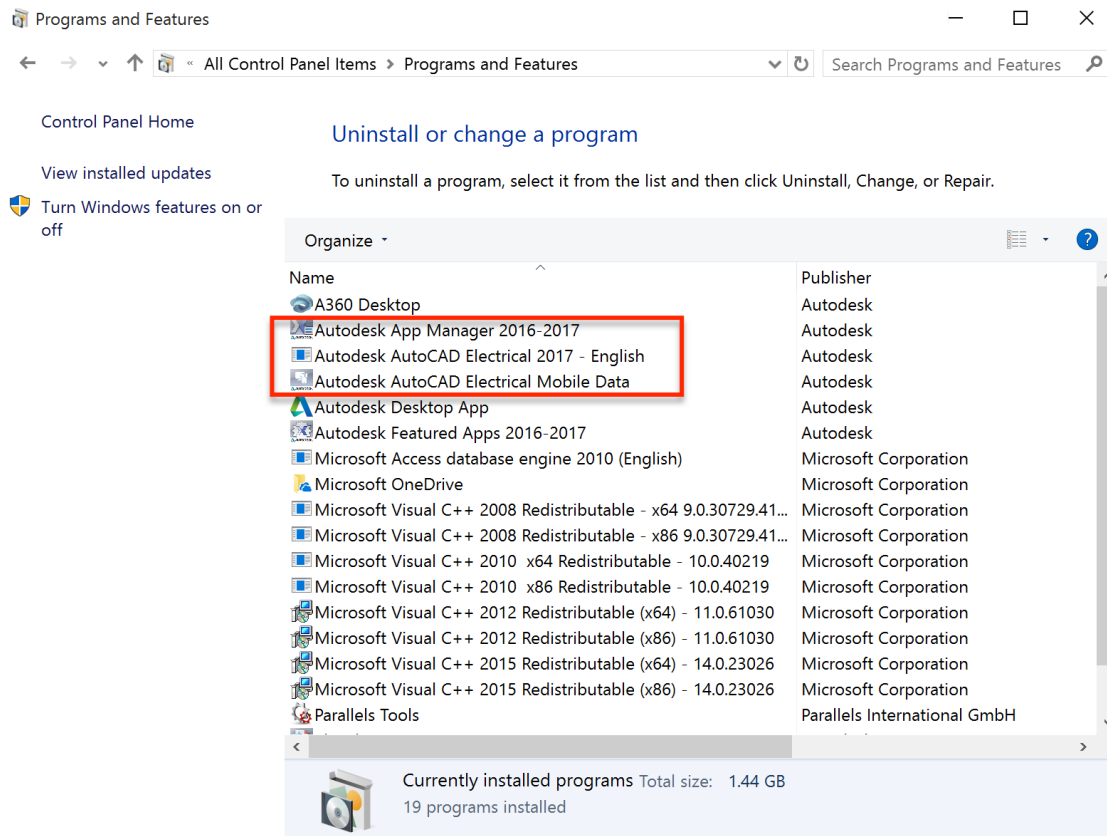


- Wait for the process to complete and then exit the utility

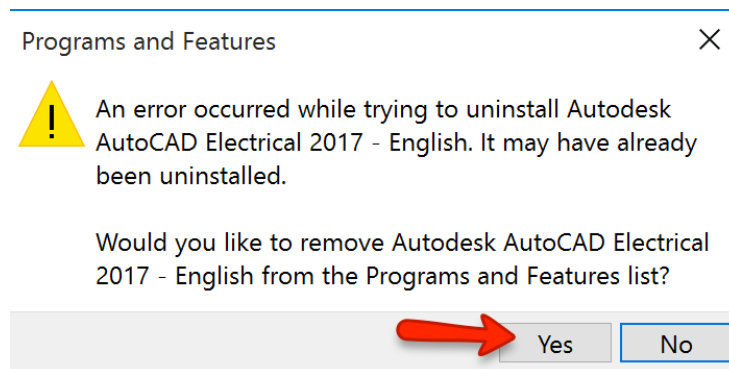


- Manually delete the folders from the below locations:
 - o C:\Program Files\Autodesk\AutoCAD 2017
 - o C:\ProgramData\Autodesk\ACAD_E
 - o C:\ProgramData\Autodesk\AutoCAD 2017
 - o C:\ProgramData\Autodesk\AutoCAD Electrical 2017
 - o C:\ProgramData\Autodesk\ADUT
 - o C:\ProgramData\FlexNet
 - o C:\Users\\AppData\Local\Autodesk\AutoCAD Electrical 2017
 - o C:\Users\\AppData\Roaming\Autodesk\ACAD_E
 - o C:\Users\\AppData\Roaming\Autodesk\AutoCAD Electrical 2017
 - o C:\Users\\Documents\Acade 2017
 - o C:\Users\Public\Public Documents\Autodesk\Acade 2017
 - o C:\Users\Public\Public Documents\Autodesk\AutoCAD Electrical 2017
- Using the registry editor, manually delete the folders:
 - o HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Autodesk\AutoCAD\R21.0
 - o HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\Software\Autodesk\AutoCAD\R21.0
 - o HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\Software\Autodesk\AutoCAD Electrical 2017 – English
- Reboot the machine

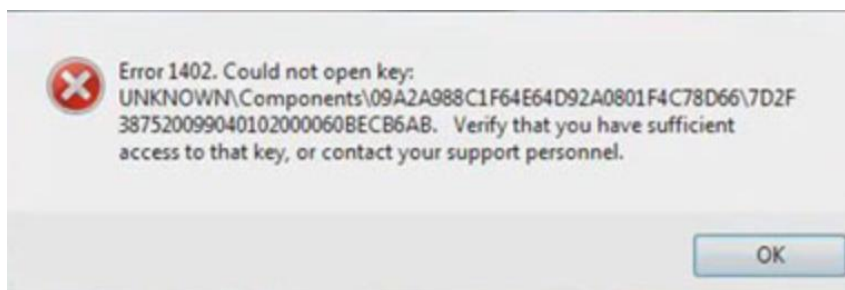
- From the Windows Control Panel, select programs and features to remove the last of the AutoCAD items



- Select each one in turn to highlight and un-install
 - o If you receive a warning, select Yes to clear from the list



- When you attempt to re-install, you may find that the below error occurs during installation
