


Project Description Dialogue Line Prompts

AutoCAD Electrical

When a new project is created, the user is faced with a dialogue box where project description information can be entered. As a default, the dialogue shows Line 1 to 12 inclusive with an unlimited number of line values that can be defined. To ensure consistency of information on how this data is entered, the line values should be altered to match the descriptions the user wishes to see, thus ensuring consistency in the way that users enter the data. The line values can be modified.


The descriptions of *LINE1*, *LINE2*, *LINE3* etc. can be modified and maintained within a text file.

AutoCAD® Electricals' Project Descriptions can be modified. The most common method is to create a text file called DEFAULT_WDTITLE.WDL and place this file in either a Support directory, the *Proj* directory or the individual projects directory.

Start-up *Notepad*.



Type the following information as shown in the example below:

If the file is saved within the individual project's directory, the text prompts are unique to that specific project.

If you save the file in one of the Support directories or the *Proj* directory, then the prompts are used for all new projects. However, an individual project can also have the *default_wdttitle.wdl* in its unique directory and these prompts are used in this instance, meaning that a specific client may have their own project record card fields which are different to your companies' normal fields.

This basically means that the prompts shown are bespoke to the specific project. If you want to reuse these prompts you can either manually copy the text file or use the *Copy Project* command. More information on the *Copy Project* can be found on the Cadline Community.

AutoCAD® Electrical searches for the text file in the following order:

1. Look in the same directory as the projects .WDP file for a file called PROJNAM_WDTITLE.WDL
2. Look in the same directory as the projects .WDP file for a file called DEFAULT_WDTITLE.WDL
3. If WD_ACADPATHFIRST flag is present in wd.env file, look for DEFAULT_WDTITLE.WDL in ACAD paths
4. Look for DEFAULT_WDTITLE.WDL in the AutoCAD Electrical USER directory
5. If WD_SUP_ALT is defined in the wd.env file, look for DEFAULT_WDTITLE.WDL in the specified path
6. Look for DEFAULT_WDTITLE.WDL in base AutoCAD Electrical directory
7. Look for DEFAULT_WDTITLE.WDL in ACAD paths (if WD_ACADPATHFIRST flag is not set in wd.env)

If, however, you save the file to the following directory of:

C:\Users\<<your user name>>\AppData\Roaming\Autodesk\AutoCAD Electrical 2021\R24.0\enu\Support



The prompts that are shown in the *Project Descriptions* dialogue will be permanently changed.

If you enter a value of “ ” for a specific line value, the line value text will be blanked

e.g. “LINE5= ”
